

Below are questions received and responses provided for the Request for Annual Hydrologic, Hydraulic, and Geomorphic Services through Wednesday, May 31, 2017:

Who is your current annual consultant for Annual Hydrologic, Hydraulic, and Geomorphic Services?

The County's current annual consultant for Annual Hydrologic, Hydraulic, and Geomorphic Services is Northwest Hydraulics Consultants.

Will this contract include design for bridges or culvert replacements?

At this time it is not anticipated that this Annual Hydrologic, Hydraulic, and Geomorphic Services will be used for the design of bridges or culvert replacements. That work is currently being done either in-house or provided by the consultant selected for our Annual Wetland and Streams Services. However, this may be an option in the future if the majority of work requires significant hydraulic evaluation.

Is the budget of \$125,000 the maximum budget for this work?

No, if necessary, as projects arise, the agreement may be supplemented for additional time and/or money.

Does permitting assistance include filling out permits for the County?

At this time the County anticipated permitting assistance would include items such as the preparation of USACE permit drawings and zero-rise analysis. Permitting is anticipated to be completed in house.

The RFQ states the proposal shall be limited to 10 pages, double sided if needed. Does that mean 10 sheets of paper that can be single sided or double sided (which would result in either 10 or 20 pages of text)? Or 10 pages where each side of a sheet of paper counts as a page?

It means 10 sheets of paper that can be single sided or double sided (which would result in either 10 or 20 pages of text).

Also, resumes (or at least bioparagraphs) would need to be included in that 10-20 page limit?

Yes, anything over the page limit will not be read.

Under "Submittal," the RFP states:

Interested consultants shall provide a statement of qualifications, experience and **extent of involvement** for the assigned personnel on similar projects. What information do you want to represent the extent of involvement of each staff member on a project? Is each person's role on the project sufficient, or do you want more detailed information of some sort?

A role would be sufficient though it may be helpful to list amount of time each person is anticipated to be utilized and/or the availability of this person to work on Lewis County projects.
