

Landscaping (Watering) Services for Countywide Mitigation Projects

Questions and Answers

Below are the questions asked and answers given pertaining to the Request for Sealed Bids for Landscaping (Watering) Services for Countywide Mitigation Projects.

1. Is this a prevailing wage job?

No this is not a prevailing wages job. This work is considered maintenance.

2. Where are the "hydrants in the area" and who would we talk to about hydrant permits for them?

The closest hydrants to the Koontz Project are in Napavine and the closest hydrants for the Davis project are likely in Morton. The cities would need to be contacted regarding hydrant permits, meters will likely need to be installed, and the costs of water would need to be included in the bid price.

3. What is the Engineer's estimate for these Services ?

The Engineer's estimate is \$37,780.15 for these Services, this includes tax.

4. Do the water sites provided in the request for bids already have meters set up?

The watering sites provided in the request for bids are surface water withdrawal sites that are included in the County's temporary water withdrawal permits. At these sites a pump shall be used to withdraw water directly from the river. All pump intake structures must have a fish screen installed, operated, and maintained in accordance with RCW 77.75.010 and 77.57.070 and the provisions of the attached HPA.
