

RFP for Countywide Annual Cultural Resources Services

Questions and Answers

Below are the questions asked and answers given pertaining to the Request for Proposals for Countywide Annual Cultural Resources Services from June 17, 2019 to June 19, 2019.

- 1) Given the number of additional potential TIP projects that may require CR services, that the amount of archaeological monitoring that may be required is also unspecified, and that there may be additional archaeological excavation required that would prompt the DAHP excavation permit applications noted in the scope, are those the kinds of situations that may entail a supplemental agreement?

It is anticipated that any Tasks from the TIP will be added to the consultant agreement as Task Orders and if additional work will result in costs of greater than \$100,000 then a supplement will be needed.

- 2) Regarding the Townsend Road Bridge Replacement, is the bridge of an age that would require historic property inventory and assessment?

The Townsend Road Bridge was built in 1981.

- 3) Similarly, are there any known buildings or structures of historic age along the CRP 2084 APE corridor that would require a professional architectural historian to contribute their services?

There are no bridges along this corridor though there are 12 unnamed tributary crossings. I believe all of these structures are precast concrete pipes ranging in size from 12-inch to 30-inches in diameter. Additionally, there is one rectangular box at MP 11.382 4 ft in width and 6 ft in height that may have been installed as a cattle crossing (see picture below).
