NOTICE TO CONSULTANTS FOR
SHOREY ROAD BANK STABILIZATION PROJECT

Lewis County solicits interest from consulting firms with expertise in Civil and Structural Engineering Design, Environmental Permitting, and scheduling. This agreement will be for approximately one year in duration with the option for the Lewis County to extend it for additional time and money if necessary. Consultants will be considered for the following project.

The Lewis County reserves the right to amend terms of this “Request for Qualifications” (RFQ) to circulate various addenda, or to withdraw the RFQ at any time, regardless of how much time and effort consultants have spent on their responses.

Project Description

The work to be performed by the CONSULTANT consists of preparing preliminary engineering design for permanent repair and stabilization for the Shorey Road Bank Stabilization Project at MP 0.598-0.691. The incidental repair of Shorey Road has been recently completed from erosion due to flooding of the Newaukum River in January 2021. The permanent repair and stabilization will need to be completed and permitted so construction can be completed in August-September 2022 fish construction window. This project has a 16% DBE requirement. The major features of the project are as follows:

- Complete design, plans and specifications for the final repair and stabilization.
- Environmental documentation and preparation of permit applications for the final repair and stabilization
- Right-of-way determinations
- Detailed schedule with critical path.

The Lewis County reserves the right to retain the services of the successful firm(s) for any subsequent phases (R/W, CN) associated with this/these project(s).

Evaluation Criteria

Submittals will be evaluated and ranked based on the following criteria:

- 1) Qualification of Proposed Project Manager
- 2) Qualifications/Expertise of Firm
- 3) Ability to meet schedule
- 4) Approach to project
- 5) Familiarity with WSDOT/FHWA standards
- 6) Past Performance/References
